

## EXERCISES WITH WILL OR GOING TO

Directions: Put the verb into the correct form, using **will** or **going to**.

Examples: **Dwayne:** Why are you turning on the TV?

**Alexina:** I'm going to watch (watch) the special report on hoarders.

**Ann:** Oh, I just realized – I don't have any money on me.

**Santiago:** No need to worry. I'll lend (lend) you some.

The clouds are very dark, aren't they? I think it is going to rain (rain).

1. Part A: I've got a terrible toothache.  
Part B: Oh, do you? Wait here and I \_\_\_\_\_ (get) the number of a great dentist.
2. Part A: Where are you going with that hose?  
Part B: I \_\_\_\_\_ (wash) the car.
3. Part A: I've decided to repaint my bedroom.  
Part B: Oh, you have? What color \_\_\_\_\_ (you, paint) it?
4. Part A: Look! Over there! There's smoke coming out of that building. It's on fire.

11. Part A: What should we have for dinner?

Part B: I don't know. I can't make up my mind.

Part A: Come on, you. Hurry up! I don't have all day. Make a decision!

Part B: Okay. We \_\_\_\_\_ (have) chicken parmesan.

12. Jim: We need some bread for lunch.

*Before he leaves, Jerry talks to Louise:*

Jerry: I \_\_\_\_\_ (buy) some bread. Do you need anything from the store?

Louise: Yes, I need today's newspaper.

Jerry: Okay, I \_\_\_\_\_ (buy) you one.

13. *Francisco has to go to the airport to catch a plane. He doesn't have a car:*

Francisco: Pablo, could you take me to the airport tonight?

Pablo: Of course, brother. I \_\_\_\_\_ (take) you. I'd be happy to.

*Later that day, Alexina offers to take Francisco to the airport.*

Alexina: Francisco, do you want me to give you a lift to the airport?

Francisco: No thanks, Alexina. Pablo \_\_\_\_\_ (take) me.
