Directions: Using any of the conjunctions from the box below, combine the independent clauses that talk about Kevin's day.

AFTER	BEFORE	WHEN	AS	WHILE

- 6 PM – Kevin went to Supermaxi to buy some food to cook.
- 6:30 PM – Kevin cooked some spaghetti and meatballs.
- 7 PM – Kevin called Steve to see what was up.
- 7:15 PM – Kevin drank some red wine while eating dinner.
- 9 PM – Kevin watched *Desperate Housewives*.
- 10:30 PM – Kevin lay down to fall asleep.
- 11 PM – Kevin finally fell asleep.
- 11:01 PM – Kevin heard his message alert on his phone and he woke up suddenly.
