ALL included:

- Everything** → Everything is ready for the party tonight.
- Everybody** → Everybody can come to the game if he has a ticket.
- Everyone** → Everyone needs to use a pencil for this quiz.

SPECIFIC but unknown:

- Something** → Something is wrong with my finger. It hurts.
- Somebody** → Somebody told me you had a girlfriend. I thought you were single!
- Someone** → Someone parked illegally and left his car lights on.

Questions / Negative Sentences (99% of the time)

- Anything** → Don't you know anything about being polite?
- Anybody** → Does anybody have an extra pencil I can borrow?
- Anyone** → I just moved here, so I don't know anyone yet.

None included:

- Nothing** → Nothing is wrong with your finger.
- Nobody** → Nobody helped me with my paragraph. I did it alone.
- No one** → No one is allowed to enter Fulbright without proper identification.
